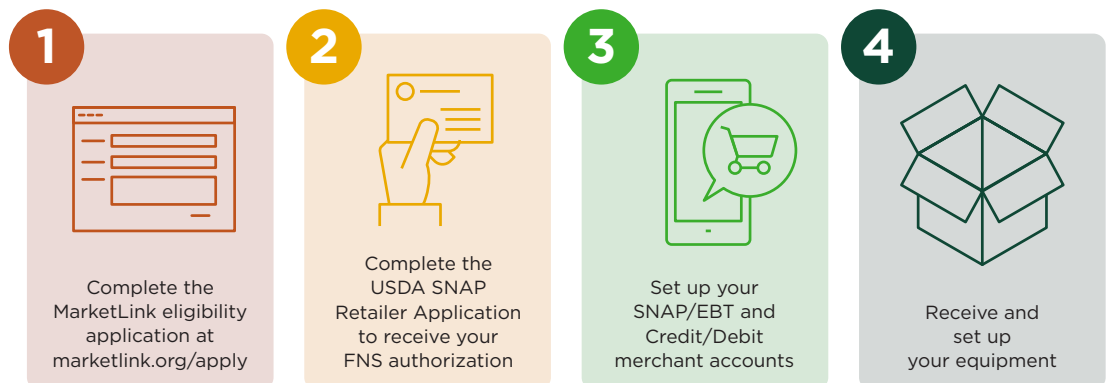

- One-on-one assistance with the USDA SNAP Retailer Application
- Free Bluetooth SNAP/EBT card reader
- 1-year free use of the TotilPay Go point-of-sale App for processing payments
- No “per-transaction” processing fees for SNAP/EBT
- Printer waiver - no printer/printed receipts required for SNAP sales
- Option to add integrated Credit/Debit processing through Square
- Equipment and support services valued at \$400
